Bred and selected for its profusion of flowers that attract butterflies. Root hardy to USDA Zone 5 and stem hardy in warmer locations. Chrysalis is tolerant of rain and has a high drought tolerance once established. The series is downy mildew resistant, too.


3. Lysimachia 'Firefly' and 'Night Light'

Jelitto Perennial Seeds

1. ALYSSUM (AURINIA) saxatile 'Gold Kobold'

The Basket-of-Gold has botanically been known as Alyssum saxatile. The recent Genus change to Aurinia does not change anything. There is a whole range of tried-and-tested, good varieties in the trade that are spring-blooming and are a nectar source for insects. The new 'Gold Kobold' variety will change things. Numerous, golden yellow flowers from March to May and again in September to October with a compact growth of only 6 inches above the vigorous, silvery foliage are features of this new variety. 'Gold Kobold' blooms in the first year after being sown late in spring, without any vernalization or overwintering.

2. CAMPANULA trachelium fl. pl. 'Flore Pleno Mix'

Campanula trachelium 'Flore Pleno Mix', the nettle-like double bellflower, is one of those perennials that is simply a joy in the garden. As a sturdy plant, it is ideally adapted to all kinds of climatic conditions. It tolerates dry periods in summer and light soils, loves the sun and feels at home in partial shade, competes against weeds and is sturdy and upright. Up close, the lovely bell-shaped flowers appear porcelain-like in detail. As beautiful as the nuances of the double, violet, light blue and white flowers may be, a mass planting produces a breathtaking sight from July to September.

3. 'Wellington Bronze'

On our new for 2021 list is Haloragis erecta f. purpurea 'Wellington Bronze'. Named for the capital city of New Zealand, this colorful (reddish florettes and glossy bronze-red leaves) semi-evergreen perennial is great for containers or in the border. About 16 inches tall. Hardy in Zones 5-10.

Must Have Perennials

1. Buddleja davidii 'Butterfly Gold' USPPAF

USDA Zones 5-11. Add elegance and beauty to the garden with Buddleja 'Butterfly Gold'. This lightly scented shrub sports a dense, compact habit with large, mauve-purple flower spikes, adding multi-color interest to garden beds and mixed borders all summer long. Hardy and easy to care for and thrives in full sun to semi-shade. Grows 6 feet tall with a spread of 5 feet. Plant was discovered by UK gardener Judy Hurley.

2. Geranium wallichianum 'Hexham Velvet' USPP#29455

USDA Zones 5. Features large, saucer-shaped single flowers of vivid pink and a smaller, lower-growing habit that distinguish this selection from 'Rozanne' and other hardy Geranium varieties. Its marbled dark green leaves are deeply cut and divided and take on red flushes in autumn. Bushy clumps grow 14 inches (35 cm) tall and 39 inches (100 cm) wide. Flowers summer into early autumn. Plant one starter per 1 gallon container. This disease-resistant variety is from UK geranium breeders Cyril Foster and Robin Moss.

(NEW).

3. Campanula Clockwise™ Compact White Blush

The first F1 hybrid *Campanula portenschlagiana* offering fast, uniform production. First-year flowering with no vernalization required. Dark blue flowers along with matching White Blush on a dense, compact habit requiring less plant growth regulators. Delivers highly uniformed habit and flowering time. Pollinator plant. 'String Theory' can be described as a compact version of the industry standard *Amsonia hubrichtii*. The compact habit is covered with light periwinkle blue flowers in late spring, flowering later than 'Storm Cloud'. While other *Amsonia* can often display chlorotic leaves, 'String Theory' displays healthy dark green leaves throughout the summer. We have observed the same brilliant golden orange fall color as you would expect from *A. hubrichtii*. Zones 4-9.

2. Leucanthemum superbum AMAZING DAISIES® 'Banana Cream II' PPAF CPBRAf

This improvement on the classic 'Banana Cream' takes all of the characteristics that gardeners love and kicks them up a notch. Just like the original, flower buds are lemon yellow and eventually brighten to creamy white. Improvements include being more floriferous, holding the yellow color longer, a more appealing habit, and earlier to start flowering. Growers will love that the vernalization week requirements are much shorter – we recommend 4-6 weeks for best performance. Zones 5-9.

3. Sedum ROCK 'N GROW® 'Back in Black' PPAF CPBRAf

New to the ROCK 'N GROW® collection comes an upright *Sedum* with near black leaves. Enjoy the dark leaf foliage throughout the summer, and when late summer rolls around, flowers with deep garnet red centers and cream petals will appear. Great for adding a dark color to the middle of the border! Zones 3-9.

ARABIS



ANDROPOGON

An **Intrinsic** introduction! **'Holy Smoke'** features silvered foliage that highlights nearly all season long from May until October. A blend of smokey purple and red add dimension over the



silvered foliage. Substantial plants reach 6-7' tall. Full sun, most any soil.

BEE BALM

Bee Balm typically bloom in midsummer, but **'Leading Lady Razzberry'** from **Walters Gardens** leads the way in early summer, flowering earlier and forming a more petite clump than other Bee Balm. **'Leading Lady Razzberry'** produces bright raspberry purple flowers on dark green leaves that have a purple cast and dark bracts. Zones 4-8. A Proven Winners perennial.



An **Intrinsic** introduction!

'Midnight Oil' plants were selected for better vigor, cleaner, less disease-prone foliage along with glossy foliage that emerges chocolate red/purple. Plants get around 18" tall and not quite that wide. Flowers are light pink with wine red colored spots beginning in June. They like full sun to light shade and dry to well drained average soil. The brown seed heads will last throughout winter too.



BUDDLEIA

Violet-cascade This plant is perfect for late season flower color! **'Violet Cascade'** from **Walters Gardens**

has the same cascading habit as the other members of the series, but with deep purple, cascading flowers. Through four years of monitoring for sterility we have not observed seed set — a stand out trait among Buddleia. Zones 5-10.

CALIBRACHOA

The **Rainbow Calibrachoa** series is the newest lineup to the **Dümmen Orange** portfolio.



These vigorous varieties have a unique characteristic that causes the bloom color to change based on temperature, light level and day length when the bud is initiated, giving a constantly changing tricolor effect to the plants. The overall tones will be richer and deeper colors in the early spring and autumn seasons, and brighter, more vibrant tones in the summer months. Rainbow varieties are extremely heat-tolerant, making them a top performer in summer baskets, large containers and even in-ground plantings.

COREOPSIS

Coreopsis Halo from **Benary** blooms up to one week earlier than other varieties with extra-large flowers. Halo has a super uniform, compact habit with dark green leaves and is excellent for premium containers. Available in primed seed, Halo is hardy to Zone 4.

has a sweet fragrance and makes a perfect show in pots, rock gardens or as a border plant. As a Fastrax perennial, it will flower the first year, without vernalization.

ECHINACEA

Echinacea 'Moab Sunset' from **Terra Nova Nurseries**



has large, double flowers in great numbers that flood the plant with color. It has a compact, upright habit that is perfect for garden beds or even containers on a sunny patio. The long-lasting flowers undergo a slow color shift, giving this superb plant added value throughout summer. Its USDA Hardiness Zones are 4-9, and it has a foliage height of 12", foliage spread of 14" and flower height of 20".

GERANIUM

Big EEZE Geraniums from **Dümmen Orange** are aptly named for their BIG blooms and EEZE



production performance. This interspecific series appears as a traditional zonal type at retail that more consumers are confident in purchasing, but with over-

sized blooms for a dramatic presentation. The interspecific ivy breeding gives these plants a resilient dose of performance through the hottest summer months. The new Big EEZE Sakura has a cherry blossom-like color and some of the most oversized blooms we've ever seen.

HEUCHERA

Heuchera 'Black Forest Cake' from **Terra Nova Nurseries** has smooth, dark-chocolate



foliage topped with bright cherry-red flowers. This heuchera has an excellent habit and its showy flowers are a great addition to any perennial foliage lineup. spring and summer attracting pollinators with its minty-fragrant foliage. Plants are first-year flowering, but scale to 3 ft. in their second year. The non-fading, dark-purple blooms are showy on an excellent mounding habit. Hardy in USDA zones 5a-9a.

PENNISETUM
 An **Intrinsic**

 comes to wide
 gold foliage in a



hardy grass for full sun.. Foliage reaching 1/2” wide is substantial and showy peaking in July just before the reddish bottle brush flowers begin. Plants reach 30-36” tall. Will work in containers too. Full sun, average soil.

RUDBECKIA
 The **SmileyZ series** of *Rudbeckia hirta*, presented by **Emerald Coast Growers**, is Dutch-bred to be more uniform than seed varieties for uniform cropping. These varieties are naturally well-branched for superior, sturdy pot performance. Colors



include Brilliant, with tons of gold bi-colored sunflowers; Tiger, which has semi-double flowers with yellow tips; and Lemon, with the brightest flowers of the group — lemon-yellow with a golden glow. All feature rich dark chocolate centers.

SALVIA
 A breakthrough
