\$6.7M provided in grant funds to support sorting improvements and community education

20M people impacted through improved recycling in the U.S.

The Coalition is celebrating the significant impact made in only two years while recognizing that the work to support PP recycling must go further. The Coalition will continue to lead efforts to increase curbside access to PP recycling, support sortation equipment upgrades, and ensure PP domestic end markets continue to grow.

Goals

- Increase access to curbside recycling for PP
- Ensure recycling facilities can sort PP
- Support domestic end markets



Approach

The Coalition's efforts are focused on providing grants to increase recovery and ensure effective sortation of PP as well as providing community education and outreach.



Structure

All members of the PP value chain are encouraged to join the Coalition. There are several funding levels available.

Steering Committee Funders guide the strategic direction and advise on major decisions. Capped at ten funders.

Supporting and Value Chain Champion Funders assist with the strategic direction and provide input on decisions. No participation cap.

The Advisory Committee is comprised of representatives from industry organizations who provide insights and expertise to inform the strategy and project specific efforts. Advisors are nominated and do not have a funding requirement.
