1. *Schizachyrium scoparium* 'Little Red Fox' PPAF

This native ornamental grass was selected for its compact size and beautiful color. Fine-textured blue-green foliage in spring with red highlights beginning mid-summer. When the nights begin to cool the foliage takes on tones of red, purple and silver. Very sturdy habit all winter long. Height 24-30"; Full Sun; Hardy in Zones 3-9.

2. *Schizachyrium scoparium* 'Sandhill' PPAF

A gorgeous native ornamental grass with wider blades than most little bluestems. Upright sturdy habit with powder-blue foliage. Fall color in tones of orange and red. Height 4'; Full Sun; Hardy in Zones 3-9.

3. *Schizachyrium scoparium* Shining Star™ PP33433

An Emerald Coast Growers introduction! A game-changing, highly ornamental version of this stalwart native grass species. 18" Basal foliage is brightly variegated, with green and light gold (white in very high light) stripes. 30" flower stems are strongly upright, with no lodging. Hardy in Zones 4-10.

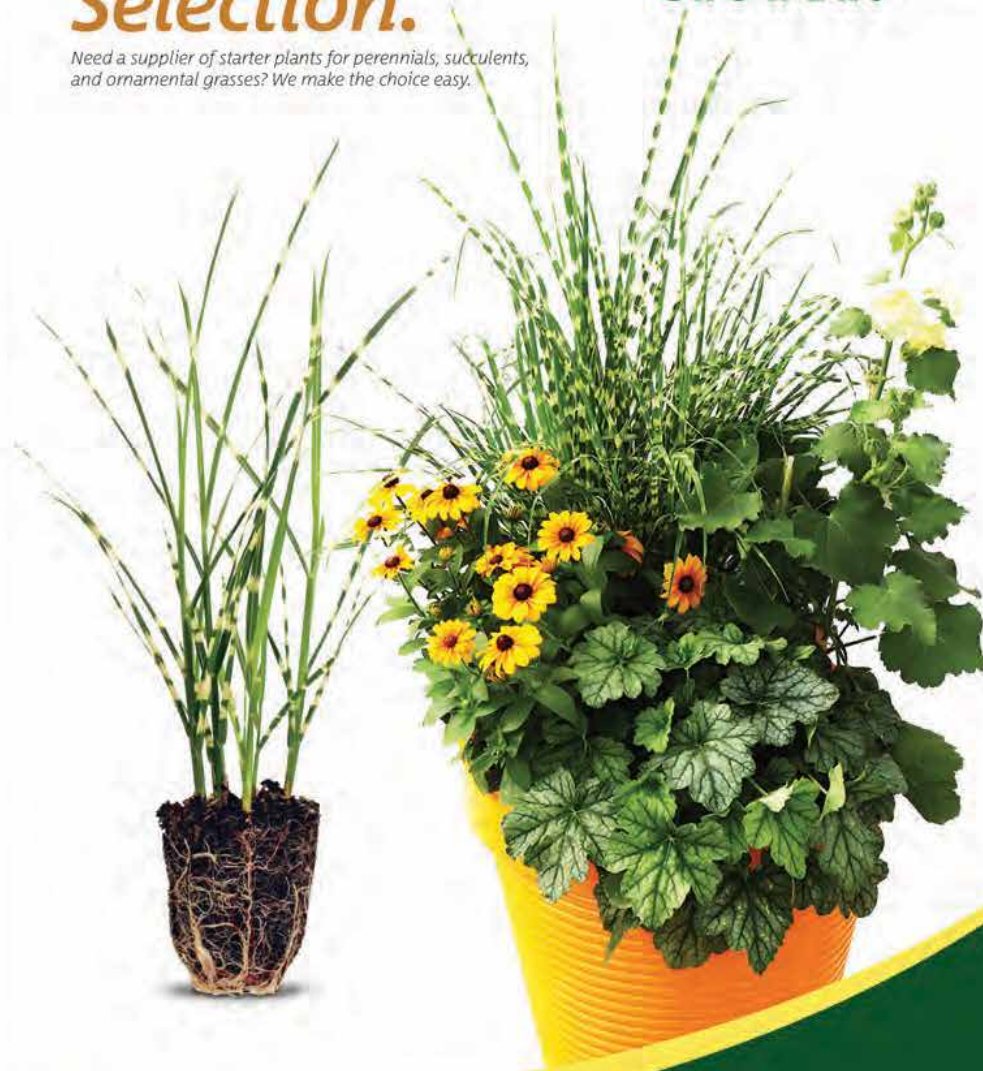

1. Aster × 'Thunderdome' PPAF

New for 2023! This hybrid of aromatic aster and New England aster has the purple flower from New England and fragrant foliage and bushy substantial plants from Aromatic aster. Large plants in the garden will grow two to three feet tall and up to three feet wide. A new color break in this type of aster. Full sun, average to dry soil.

2. Rudbeckia × 'Green Eyed Lady' PPAF

New for 2023! A new look in rudbeckia, this one begins with green-eyed flowers softening to chartreuse yellow and eventually turning brown. Upright plants have stems to 30 inches tall above thin leaved rosettes of foliage. Full sun, average to dry soil.

3. Schizachyrium scoparium 'Little Red Fox' PPAF

New for 2023! 'Little Red Fox' PPAF – Bushy and vigorous plants on the shorter side of little bluestem growing 24 to 30 inches tall. Spring color is gray and green, quickly deepening and turning to the red side in mid- to late-summer. Strong basal foliage with thin wiry stems change from green to silver to red by fall. An exciting addition to the short end of grasses. Full sun, most any soil but wet.

Bergenia 'Snowtime' thrives with good drainage and positioned in full to part sun. More shade is needed in hot summer climates. If given what it likes, it will reward you with seasons of snow-white delight. 'Snowtime' is perfect for spring and autumn garden center sales, seasonal container plantings, and will continue to support the pollinating community well into the fall.

3. LEWISIA Longipetala-Hybr. 'Little Tutti Frutti'

1. Artemisia 'Silver Lining'

A hybrid of native North American species including Artemisia ludoviciana. 'Silver Lining' finds the best in its parentage as a spectacular, durable foliage perennial. Broadly dissected silver leaves are showy from spring to fall. The mounded, low and wide habit maintains perfect form all season and resists opening up. Use this perennial as a filler in the landscape and spiller in mixed containers. Zones 4-9. A Proven Winners perennial.

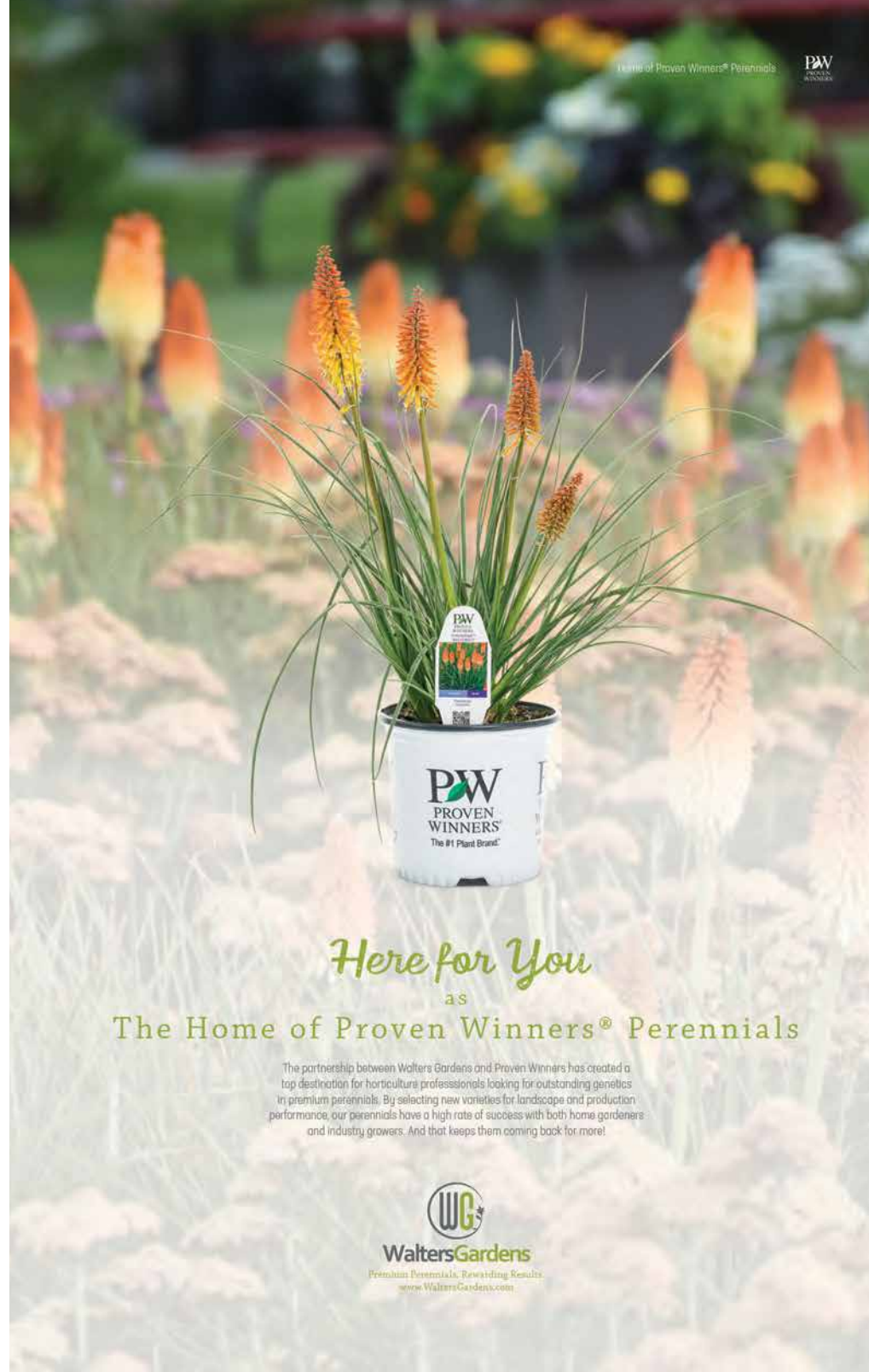
2. Phlox 'Prismatic Pink'

3. Sedum 'Midnight Velvet'

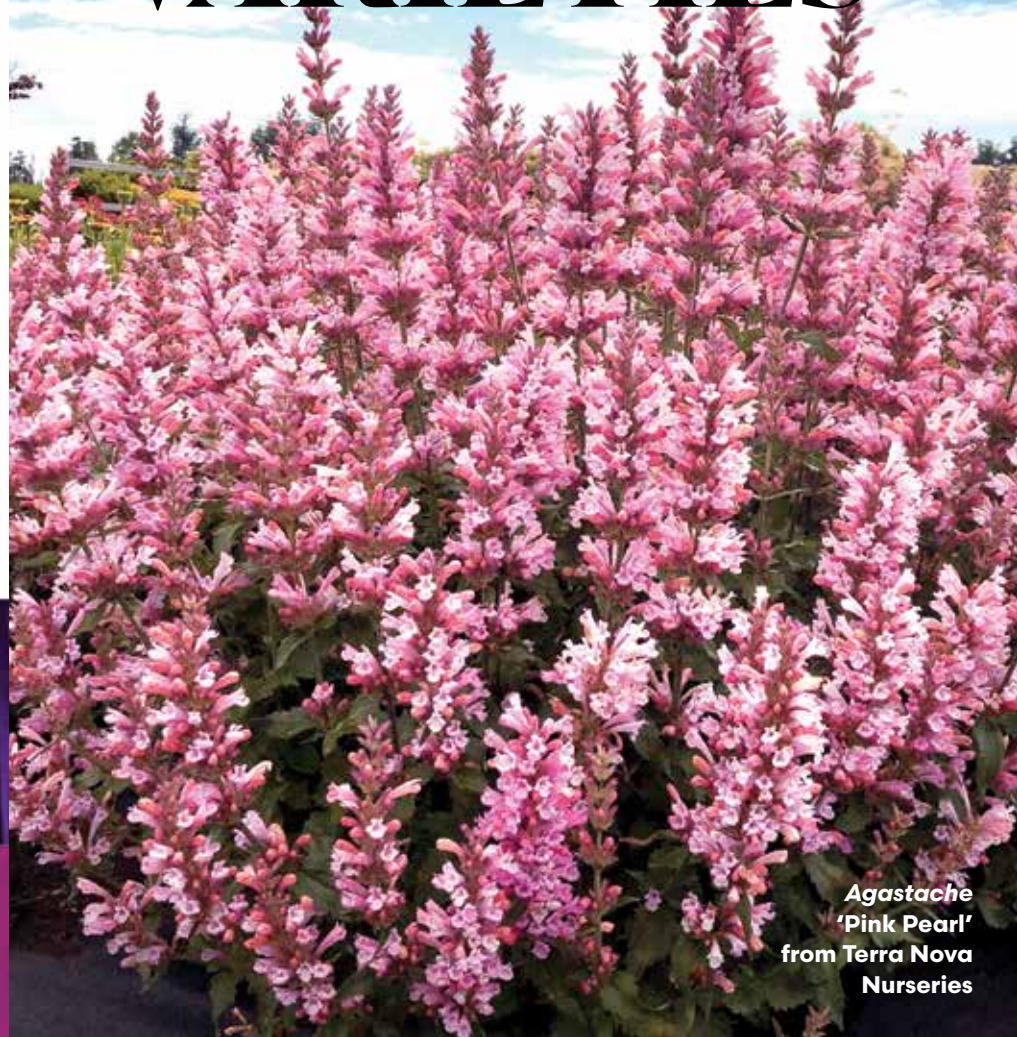

AGASTACHE

Dümmen Orange's new **Honeysticks series** has very large flowers with a medium compact habit of no more than 20 in/51 cm. It performs through heat and humidity in the garden with bright retail colors like Ember, Purple and Sandstone. Plus, pollinators love it.



Agastache **'Pink Pearl'** from **Terra Nova Nurseries** showcases a mid-sized, full and compact mound of large flower spikes with an incredibly unique, glowing light pink color that brightens any garden. Dense blooms cover the entire plant, appearing in two tones with deeper-colored flower buds contrasting nicely. This variety is an eye-catcher in mid-to-front garden borders; it's also stunning in the container at home or at retail.

ARMERIA

Armeria provides frost-to-frost flowering in containers or in the garden. The Dreameria series from **Darwin Perennials** is heat tolerant and easy to grow, with large-size flowers on sturdy stems for excellent color presentation. New **'Vivid Dreams'** is an attractive, deep purple variety with a tidy habit perfect for landscape borders or patio mixed containers. Hardiness Zones 5a to 9a.

CENTAUREA

The foliage of this stunning, silver-

white centaurea will brighten any space and attract the eye in mixed plantings.



Silver Swirl from **Darwin Perennials** has gracefully wavy leaf edges that add texture to combos in planters or as a border in the landscape. Plants are drought tolerant once established and low maintenance. Easy to grow and inspiring to use. Hardiness Zones 6b to 9b. New for 2024.

CARYOPTERIS

The dense clusters of blue flowers on this plant in late summer and fall attract pollinators.



Caryopteris **'Emerald Crest'** from **Darwin Perennials** is a compact plant featuring glossy green leaves and a nice, mounded habit, which makes it an excellent addition to landscape designs. Provides a better-finished plant with a high-impact, seasonal color show. Hardiness Zones 6a to 9a.

COREOPSIS

Coreopsis NOVA **'Jewel'** from **Terra Nova Nurseries** displays cream, rose and lavender tones that change with the seasons. The tight, clean habit complements the unusual flowers to

make this plant a standout amongst fans of coreopsis. 'Jewel' is ideal for mixed beds, borders, mass plantings, containers and as an accent. This variety is also a favorite among bees and other pollinators.

ECHINACEA

Improved flower coverage helps this coneflower make a bold statement in landscapes and patio gardens. The new Deluxe breeding of the **Double Scoop series** from **Darwin Perennials** brings the branching, flower count and timing of the established Sombrero series to this improved collection. It's more compact than typical double-flowered echinacea. The vibrant colors are brilliantly attractive. Hardiness Zones 4a to 9b. New for 2024.

The first F1 hybrid seed Echinacea collection is expanding. **New Yellow Ombre** from **Kieft Seed** joins the Artisan Collection of seed Echinacea that offers consistency of plant structure for uniform and highly branched, full plants. The series also provides uniformity of flowering, so all plants are ready to sell at the same time. Plus, the benefits of a seed input provide flexibility for production, so it fits better into your schedule. Hardiness Zones 4a to 10b.



The first seed-grown Echinacea with earliness and uniformity optimized for mass production and with a wide enough color range to offer a true alternative to vegetative varieties. **Prairie Blaze** from

GERANIUM

'Huggy Bear' from **Intrinsic Perennial Gardens** features chocolatey red foliage and is larger in size than the species, growing 5 to 6 inches wide. Clear pink flowers bloom in May on 15- to 18-inch stems. This form also has better disease resistance to foliar spotting. Full sun to part shade, average soil.



HEUCHERELLA

A Heucherella set to capture your attention! **FUN AND GAMES 'Capture the Flag'** from **Walters Gardens** is a large-leaved variety that has deeply lobed

chartreuse leaves with dramatic burgundy red centers. In late spring, clouds of white flowers appear on light colored stems above the foliage. 'Capture the Flag' will put up new leaves early in the season and hold foliage interest through the fall, with winter color showing in warmer zones without snow cover. Hardiness Zones 4 to 9. A **Proven Winners** perennial.

HIBISCUS

SUMMERIFIC 'All Eyes on Me' from **Walters Gardens** is one of our most compact hardy hibiscus to date. Despite its scaled-down size, 'All Eyes on Me' keeps the trademark massive 8" blooms the plant has become known for. The blushing pink blooms appear from the top to the bottom of a well-rounded habit of dark green leaves. Heavily overlapping petals give the impression the flowers are

semi-double, particularly as each bud unfurls. Hardiness Zones 4 to 9. A **Proven Winners** perennial.

HOSTA SHADOWLAND 'Love Story' from **Walters Gardens**

features long heart-shaped leaves with medium green margins with chartreuse jetting that bleeds into creamy white centers. The medio-variegation extends from leaf tip to the petiole, flaring at the base of the leaf. A gentle picrust wave edges each leaf. Tall scapes hold large clusters of tubular white flowers in early summer, creating a Hosta that can be enjoyed for its foliage and flowers. Hardiness Zones 3 to 9. A **Proven Winners** perennial.



IBERIS

With its super-compact, mounding habit and flowers beginning in early summer, Iberis hybrid **Candy Sorbet** from **Dümmen Orange** fills an important space for June and July bloomers. Its purply-pink flowers are one of the most unique colors within the category and bloom for upwards of six weeks. Mounding clouds of blooms sit atop beautiful dark-green foliage.



LAVANDULA

Lavandula angustifolia **'Lovely Sky'** is a new lavender from **Hem Genetics** from seed that will flower its first year with no vernalization, so it can be used as a first-year flowering perennial. Hardy in USDA Zones 5 to 8, winter sown plants will flower in 16-20 weeks. This non-vernalization attribute will also allow this variety to be utilized as a pot crop for spring holiday sales where it traditionally can't be grown, such as in the deep south.

LEUCANTHEMUM

Leucanthemum x superbum 'Arctic Snow' from Hem Genetics is another new first-year perennial that will flower in 16-20



weeks from sowing with no vernalization. Ideal for 6" pots or larger, these produce beautiful pure white daisies and in the garden will get to 18 inches with a spread of 16 inches. Hardy in USDA Zones 5 to 8. Plants are strong and well-branched, producing a pot full of flowers on finish with great consumer appeal.

From Dümmen Orange, Sweet Daisy Izabel's remarkable yellow flowers will shine like the sun in the early summer



landscape. With a high heat and humidity tolerance, the breakthrough with Izabel is its compact (14-16 in/35-41 cm) habit. Cooling and vernalization benefits its early flowering, improves flower count and enhances color.

From **Dümmen Orange**, **Sweet Daisy Shelly** is petite perfection in a *Leucanthemum*! A breeding breakthrough brings us this compact daisy with a flawless mounding habit. It is a first-year flowering, classic-white daisy, but with a large button-sized yellow center.

'**Chartreuse on the Loose**' is a perennial from **Walters Garden** with season-long interest perfect for lining the front of the border. The foliage allows for a full three seasons of interest with bright chartreuse yellow leaves. Clusters of lavender blue flowers are produced just above the foliage and appear all summer long. Unlike most catmint, 'Chartreuse on the Loose' will continue to produce flowers without being cut back. Hardiness Zones 3 to 8.

PENSTEMON

Penstemon '**Flock of Flamingos**' from **Terra Nova Nurseries** showcases a new color from the same breeding as 'Pink Chablis' with low, dense and glossy growth. This variety is a top pollinator attractor. It has continuous blooming from early spring through frost and enjoys lavender-purple flower spikes that rebloom when spent flowers are removed.

PEROVSKIA

This novelty variety has a controlled habit, early flowering and early finishing, making growing *Perovskia* for the consumer and landscape *Perovskia* market easy. **Bluesette** from **Kieft Seed**

works well at the front of the landscape, in a single premium patio container or in mixed combo. Produces a pleasing fragrance and attracts bees and butterflies. Hardiness Zones 4a to 9a.

A densely branched and compact habit makes **Zephyr** from **Syngenta Flowers** the best choice for small to mid-sized containers. Soft blue flowers are held above the fine foliage all summer long. A tough and drought-tolerant variety that is also a magnet for pollinators.

POLEMONIUM

Polemonium '**Hurricane Ridge**' from **Terra Nova Nurseries** features recurring curved, frond-like foliage with an attractive geometric pattern on display throughout its growth; light lilac-blue-toned flowers grace the top of the crisp, green-leaved cyclone mid-summer. This tough and hardy perennial tolerates both sun and shade well, making it ideal for mixed sun and shade locations, containers or as added foliage texture.

RUDBECKIA

Goldblitz from **Kieft Seed** is a natural daylength growing solution. This first-year-flowering perennial provides a more economical input option for natural daylength growers, as the plugs do not require special treatment to perform to the same quality as Goldsturm. Also a recent Fleuroselect Gold Medal winner. Hardiness Zones 3a to 9b.

RUMEX

Rumex flexuosus '**Twister Red**' from **Hem Genetics** is a novel type of plant that has many opportunities for use to add color and texture to the landscape or to mixed containers for the patio, or for used as

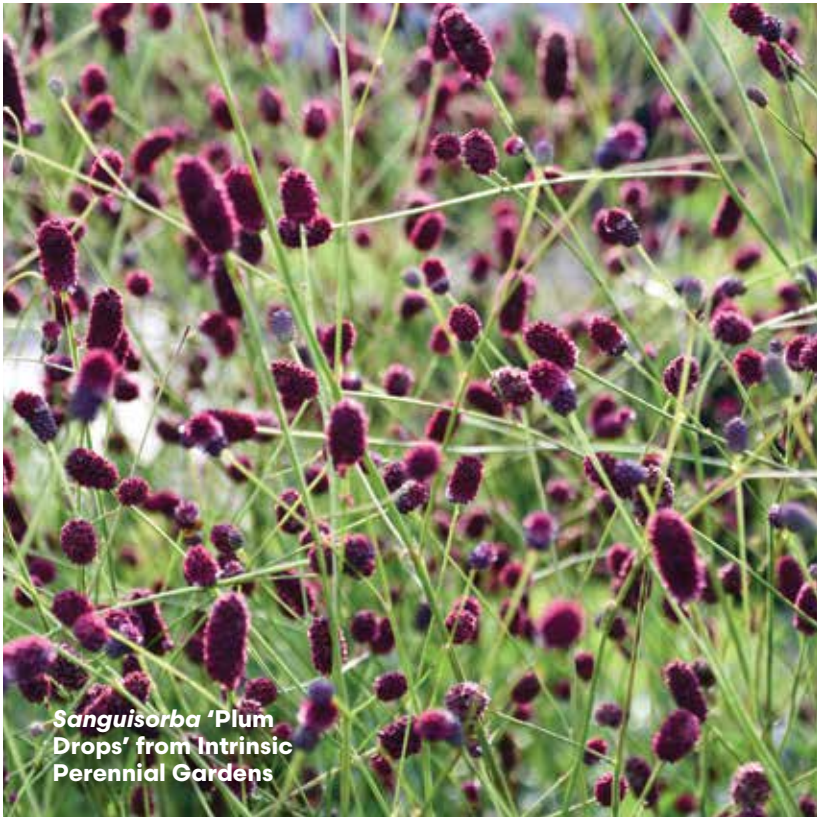
tart edible herb for salads, as it is one of the sorrels or docks. The plant has a deep copper red color, narrow strap like leaves and produces flower stems that are contorted and twisted, giving the plant a unique appearance. Hardiness Zones 6 to 9.

RUTA CHALEPENSIS

Ruta chalepensis '**Barry**' from **Hem Genetics** is often used as a medicinal herb. The common name for this species is fringed rue, a different species from the more common *R. graveolens*. This is a perfect plant to bring beautiful texture to the landscape as well as its lovely blue green foliage. 13 to 18 weeks to finish,

depending on pot size, it is hardy USDA Hardiness Zones 5 to 9. It flowers its second year with yellow bell-shaped blooms.

SALVIA

From **Dümmen Orange, Noble Knight**'s large purple-to-blue flowers will catch your eye and the plants'



flower power will keep this salvia in your production rotation. Thick, weather-tolerant flowers are self-cleaning, but the plant

remains attractive. A compact habit, great branching and early, first year flowering sweetens the deal.

SANGUISORBA

'**Plum Drops**' from **Intrinsic Perennial Gardens** features heavy blooming plants have wine colored bottle brush flowers on 3- to 4-foot tall, thin sturdy stems. Dark green pinnate foliage stays lower to the ground. Full sun, most any soil.
