While the series offers a machine for every application, the ML100 is the go-to workhorse for many landscape professionals with its 950 lb (430.9 kg) rated operating capacity (ROC) and turbocharged 25-hp (18.6-kW) diesel engine.

ENHANCED HYDRAULIC PERFORMANCE.

The ML series delivers robust, reliable hydraulic power. An updated system maximizes horsepower transfer and features improved filtration to improve the longevity of major hydraulic components, giving you the muscle to power through tough digging and consistently deliver the flow that demanding attachments require.

MORE MUSCLE AND LIFT CAPACITY. Productivity is boosted by impressive rated operating capacities (ROC) across the lineup, ranging from 760 lb (344.7 kg) on the ML80 to 1,530 lb (694 kg) on the ML150. The ML100, ML130 and ML150 models also feature turbocharged engines for additional torque when under load.

AN OPERATOR-CENTRIC DESIGN. The chariot-style operator station is designed for all-day comfort and control. A cushioned platform and supportive padding help reduce fatigue while a single pilot-operated joystick provides intuitive control for precise maneuvering.
